Meet Scout, he and animals like him are the reason we are here. Scout came to the Williams County Humane Society in August of 2013. He was part of a large humane case where many animals were being mistreated and neglected. We were so excited when Scout found a home in December of 2013. Unfortunately, things did not work out for him in that particular home and he was returned in October 2014. Scout has watched many dogs come and go in the year that he has been in our kennel, and we think it's his turn to walk out those kennel doors and never look back! In 2016 we helped numerous dogs & cats find their forever homes. Through the low cost Spay & Neuter program we also have been able to help a significant number of animal owners in the community obtain spay and neuter services for their pets that they may not have otherwise been able to afford.

We recently received a significant donation through an Endowment set up with the Bryan Area Foundation. This will allow the Shelter to receive an annual interest payment to help offset some of the operating expenses of the Shelter. However, WE STILL NEED YOUR HELP!!! The interest we will receive from this Endowment is only a small fraction of the costs that we incur throughout the year to provide food, shelter and veterinarian services to all animals that come through our doors.

As you may have read, we recently entered into a partnership with the Williams County Dog Warden to provide a space within our facility for the Warden to work from. This also will help the Shelter by providing some regular monthly income to the Shelter in the form of nominal rent being paid by the County. The Williams County Humane Society still remains a 501(c)(3) NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION and we receive NO GOVERNMENT FUNDING.

Finally, in 2016 we broke ground on a small addition on our building that will be used as a quarantine area to promote health and wellness when animals are too sick to be in our regular kennels. This addition was funded entirely by private donations from the Bryan Rotary Club and other individual donors as well as a grant from the Bryan Area Foundation. We would again like to thank them for their support.

As you can see, 2016 was a busy year for us and we look forward to a successful 2017. We cannot do that without YOU!!! Your generous donations allow us to continue our mission - which is to provide new hope to homeless, abused and neglected animals while engaging the minds, hearts and hands of the community. We strive to achieve this by providing sanctuary and compassion, along with medical attention for all domesticated animals in our care. The animals need your love and support.
